



Honorary Life Award

Description of the Award

The Honorary Life Award shall be granted to individuals who have made significant and meaningful contributions to safety, health or the environment as a member of the Campus Safety, Health and Environmental Management Association.

Objective

To recognize members who have made significant contributions for many years to safety, health and the environment and has retired and/or had a change in job responsibilities or other extenuating circumstances from a member university or college. The level of service to be recognized need not be at the level required for the CSHEMA Distinguished Safety Award (DSA), however, it should represent long term, substantial contributions and significant, meaningful accomplishments towards achieving the goals and objectives of CSHEMA.

Criteria

To qualify for the Honorary Life Award an individual must:

- have been a member in good standing of CSHEMA for a minimum of 10 years; and
- have contributed significantly to higher education safety, health and environmental protection through their participation in CSHEMA; and
- is retired and/or had a change in job responsibilities or other extenuating circumstances from a member university or college Environmental Health & Safety Program; and
- be unable to continue to serve in a full-time capacity.

Nomination Process

Any member of CSHEMA may nominate an individual who appears to meet the above criteria. Use the form provided below to submit nominations. Provide all requested information and be as complete as possible, particularly when detailing the nominee's significant contributions. Submit applications by March 31, or the next business day if it falls on a weekend.

Entries must be submitted online at <http://cshema.wufoo.com/forms/z7x3k1>. Entries should be one file, preferably PDF, and the file size should be as small as possible.

Judging

Judging of the Honorary Life Award is the responsibility of the Awards Committee and the CSHEMA Executive Committee. Nominees must be recommended by the Awards Committee and approved by the CSHEMA Board of Directors to be eligible to receive this award.

Benefits

Recipients of the Honorary Life Award will receive the following:

- lifetime membership in CSHEMA
- lifetime annual conference registration
